Romans 1:17

**For in the gospel the
righteousness of God is
revealed. A righteousness
that is by faith from first to
last. Just as it is written:
“The righteous will live
by faith.”**

Romans 15:6

**So that with one mind
and one voice you
may glorify God and
the Lord Jesus Christ.**

Is God done with Israel?

Israel's rejection
was in part not in entirety

Romans 11:1-10

I ask then: did God reject his people?

**By no means! I am an Israelite
myself, a descendant of Abraham,
from the tribe of Benjamin. God did
not reject his people, who he
foreknew.....**

Israel's rejection is
not permanent

Romans 11:11-29

**Again I ask: did they stumble
so as to fall beyond recovery?
Not at all! Rather, because of
their transgression, salvation
has come to the Gentiles.....**

Romans 11:28

But as far as election is concerned, they are loved on account of the patriarchs, for God's gifts and his call are irrevocable.

For God has bound
everyone over to
disobedience so that
he may have mercy
on them all.

Promise to Abraham

Genesis 12:2-3

**“I will make you into a great nation,
and I will bless you;
I will make your name great,
and you will be a blessing.
I will bless those who bless you,
and whoever curses you
I will curse;
and all peoples on earth
will be blessed through you.”**

Prophesied kingdom

Daniel 2:44

“In the time of those kings, the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that will never be destroyed, nor will it be left to another people. It will crush all those kingdoms and bring them to an end, but it will itself endure forever.

Presented kingdom

Matthew 14:17

From that time on Jesus began to preach, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near.”

Luke 11:20

But if I drive out demons by the finger of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.

Postponed Kingdom

Matthew 21:43

Therefore I tell you that the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people who will produce its fruit.

Physical kingdom

Revelation 11:15

The seventh angel sounded his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, which said:
“The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Messiah, and he will reign for ever and ever.”

Permanent kingdom

2 Peter 3:11-13
